when a vegetable is at its peak for harvesting and whether  
continued harvesting will result in more production.**

child, and has been a Cuyahoga County Master Gardener  
Volunteer since 2004. Prior to retirement, she taught social  
studies at Shaw High School for 25 years and served as an  
assistant principal both there and later at Chardon High School.

She is a member of the 2012 Ohio State award winning Community Gardening Committee where she trains mentors and local gardeners in the basics of vegetable gardening. As a member of the Speaker's Bureau she regularly gives at libraries, gardening clubs and Tri-C. Christine has been a frequent contributor to the "Inside/Outside" page of the Cleveland Plain Dealer, and has appeared on public radio on "Ideastream".

In 2011 she was selected as the Master Gardener Volunteer of the Year for the state of Ohio.
