Through the work from the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District's Storm Water Management Program and Project Clean Lake, our region's waterways, including Doan Brook and Lake Erie, are having legacy issues such as combined sewer overflows, flooding, erosion, and other water quality related issues that are typically associated to development addressed.
