Managing Vegetable Garden Pests without Chemicals

Managing pests in your vegetable garden without chemicals may be easier than you think. Some basic practices, in conjunction with a few natural products, will allow for the production of healthy chemical-free vegetables. We will discuss: the three most effective non-chemical supplements to combat pests; the most common pests based on vegetable family and subfamily groupings; and some aids to provide you with all the information you need when in the garden.
