Hydrangeas Not Blooming? Don't know what kind they are?

Why aren't my hydrangeas blooming? This is one of the most common questions asked about these beautiful blooming shrubs. In this presentation you will learn about the six most common species of hydrangeas, the best conditions for growing each type, and advice on how and when to prune them.

Presenter: Kim Hawkins has been a Master Gardener Volunteer since 2008. She has particular interest in perennials, shade gardening, hostas and Japanese maples.
